



**Job Title: Clinical Outreach Specialist**

The Clinical Outreach Specialist will function as a clinician and consultant primarily for the Homeless Outreach program. Main responsibilities include completing psych/social assessments and diagnoses with homeless individuals to determine eligibility for appropriate housing programs, creating individualized plans of care, and assisting with linkages to other health care resources in the community.

Other responsibilities include:

- Provide on-call and emergency medical services to other Matt Urban Hope Services programs including but not limited to PSH and Hope House
- Conduct clinical evaluations and psych/social assessments with participants
- Develops and implements plans of care, including linking to medical and or behavioral services
- Provides consultation to primary care and other medical/behavioral health service providers regarding behavioral health issues of clients
- Coordinates the services of care of patients requiring special services and participates in the development of protocols, policies and programs to facilitate the coordination of these services.
- Facilitate and act as main point of contact for UB HEALS Outreach collaboration efforts
- After six months of employment, take a leadership role on a sub-committee of the WNY Coalition for the Homeless
- Participate in weekly case conferences within Homeless Outreach Department
